All information provided in the programme is correct at the time of going to print. The organisers reserve the right to make appropriate changes as necessary.

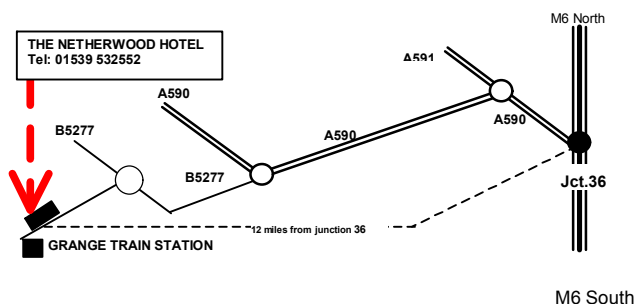
